## DIGITAL ARTICLES from Magazines, Newspapers, Journals and Online Reference Material

Using the Find Articles/Databases Resources A-Z link on the Library Homepage, search the following databases.

- Using keywords, combining them with AND, OR, NOT. Ex. Welles and Hearst.
- Print using the print button or link in the database rather than from the file pull-down menu.

**InfoTrac General OneFile**: Current articles in major magazines and journals.

Click on Keyword Search on the left.

**Academic Search Complete**: Current articles in major magazines and journals.

**History Resource Center: US**: Chapters from books, articles from periodicals, primary documents.

**Historical New York Times**: Scanned version of the New York Times archive from 1851- 2001. Limit searches to key dates or date ranges.

**Project Muse**: Scholarly articles.
